ROLE DESCRIPTION

Role of Create Central Executive Board

Executive Board Members are **private sector** industry leaders, with demonstrable specialist sector knowledge working at a national and international level. Create Central Executive Board Members are appointed to represent the creative content sector¹ on behalf of businesses in the West Midlands and have oversight of public funding, as such Members work to the highest ethical standards as enshrined in Nolan Principles of Public Life.

Members are appointed through an open recruitment process to join the Executive Board in a voluntary, non-executive capacity to:

- Provide strategic vision and oversight
- Provide ongoing market intelligence to ensure Create Central's output is industry focused
- Provide decision-making function for Create Central
- Provide checks and balances on Create Central's output, including governance, finance, and risk
- In partnership with WMCA, to appoint an Executive Team of industry specialists to support the delivery of its activities
- Provide ongoing review of the Executive Team
- Contribute to promoting the region's creative content sector during the year by agreeing to:
 - attend 2 x industry events
 - represent Create Central on 1 x industry panel
 - provide 1 x blog for Create Central's website
 - provide 1 x video content for social media use.

Board members will typically commit around 1-2 days per month to Create Central.

Executive Board appointment and term

- Founder Members² selected to remain as Executive Members will be approved by Create Central's Governance Group.
- New Executive Members will be appointed by an open recruitment process.
- Membership will be approved by the Chair of Create Central.
- Membership will reflect the creative content sub-sectors, the WMCA geographical footprint
- Members will be from the private sector (privately-owned businesses, ranging from small enterprises to large corporations).
- Membership will not exceed 15 or fall below 10.
- A guorum shall be six members.
- Membership term is three years.

¹ For the purposes of Create Central the 'Creative Content Sector' is defined as film, television, games, animation, high-end TV, branded-content, vlogger/influencer, VFX, immersive tech and those businesses directly in the supply chain. 'Industry' refers to businesses within the creative content sector supply chain.

² Members appointed to Create Central in October 2019

Chair and Vice Chairs

- The Chair will be appointed through an open recruitment process managed by WMCA.
- The term of the Chair is six years with a review by all parties at three years.
- Vice Chair may be appointed by the Chair of Create Central and a simple majority vote of members, following an internal Create Central appointment process.

Meetings

- The Executive Board will meet six times annually for 2 hours.
- Members are expected to attend all meetings.
- Meetings will be virtual.

The Governance Group is slightly different as it is a decision-making group which acts as a sub-committee of the Executive Board. It is Chaired by Create Central's Chair.

Voting

Decisions will be made by a simple majority vote.

Communication

- Members are always expected to communicate in a professional and courteous manner.
- Members should contact the Chair to raise matters relating to Create Central's delivery or the Executive Team, the Chair will report these to the Executive Lead at their weekly meeting.
- A monthly internal newsletter will keep all members up to date with activity.

Raising concerns or complaints

Members should contact the Chair at the earliest opportunity to raise concerns or complaints about Create Central.
